Enclosed is a copy of our Paper Ready Inmate Report which is reflective of the number of inmates, as reported by the counties, for whom paperwork and processing has been completed for admittance into the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division. The enclosed report encompasses the months of July 2017 through September 2017.

In September, the number of “new paper-ready inmates” decreased by 666. The average number of new paper-ready inmates per month over the last twelve months is 3,478. This month’s number is 317 less than this average. In September, the total number of paper-ready inmates held in the county jails decreased by 96 and the number of transfers from the county jails to TDCJ-ID increased by 190.
