On February 1, 2018, the total population in Texas county jails increased by 2,614 from the previous month. Statewide capacity increased by 232 from the previous month due to Kerr County completing a new jail project and Limestone (P) additional approved occupancy. Jails are now collectively operating at 69.39% of capacity. As of February 1, 2018 there were two (2) jails at 100% or more of capacity.

On February 1, 2018, thirty eight (38) TDCJ Half-Way House inmates were housed in county facilities. In addition, local facilities were housing three hundred thirty four (334) out-of-state inmates (Arkansas) in one (1) facility. The total number of contract inmates (county, federal, TDCJ and out-of-state) was 6,660.
