Training of staff for emergency situations shall be provided immediately upon employment and no less than each calendar quarter for all jail personnel to include fire, emergency, evacuation drills, and location and use of equipment.</p> <p><b>After reviewing documentation for training of staff for emergency situations to include fire, emergency, evacuation drills and location and use of equipment, it was determined that Jailer Lorie White did not receive training within the 3rd and 4th quarter of 2012 and the 1st quarter of 2013. Jailer Latisha Joslin was appointed as a jailer on 8/27/2012 and did not receive training upon employment or the 4th quarter of 2012. Joslin did participate in the quarterly training within the 1st quarter of 2013. Jailer Chase Crawford did not receive training within the 1st quarter of 2013. Jailer Stephen Collins was appointed as a jailer on 8/9/2012 and did not receive training upon employment or the 4th quarter of 2012. Collins did receive training the 1st quarter of 2013. Jailer Jacob Craig was appointed as a jailer on 10/26/2012 and did not receive training upon employment. Craig did receive training within the 1st quarter of 2013.</b></p>
