REGARDING: Mental Health Screening Form to Magistrates

When a jail notifies a magistrate that a person arrested or confined for a Class B misdemeanor or higher has a mental illness or is a person with an intellectual disability, Code of Criminal Procedure § 16.22(a)(1) requires that the jail must include with the notice any information it used to determine the inmate's mental illness or intellectual disability, such as information regarding the defendant's behavior immediately before, during, and after the person's arrest and, if applicable, the results of any previous assessment of the defendant.

In order for a jail to comply with the requirements of §16.22, the Screening Form for Suicide and Medical/ Mental/ Developmental Impairments (intake screening form) along with any other information the jail possesses will need to be submitted to the magistrate along with the magistrate notification. Providing the Screening Form for Suicide and Medical/ Mental/ Developmental Impairments to the magistrate does NOT violate HIPPA.

Effective immediately, ALL jails will be required to provide the necessary documentation to the magistrate in order to comply with Article 16.22 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. Failure to provide the necessary documentation may result in the issuance of a notice of non-compliance.
