1	263	.54	<p>At least one self-contained breathing apparatus shall be available and maintained in or near each facility control station. All staff shall be trained and quarterly drills conducted in the use of this equipment.</p> <p>During the inspection, two jailers on duty were unable to charge and/or use the Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA).</p>
2	273	.2 (12)	<p>Provide procedures that shall require that a qualified medical professional shall review as soon as possible any prescription medication a prisoner is taking when the prisoner is taken into custody.</p> <p>While reviewing medical procedures, it was determined that only a pharmacist was being utilized to review medications.</p>
3	273	.5 (b)	<p>An approved mental disabilities/suicide prevention screening instrument shall be completed immediately on all inmates admitted.</p> <p>While reviewing medical files, it was determined jail staff are not filling out the Screening Form for Suicide and Medical/Mental/Developmental Impairments in its entirety.</p>
4	285	.1	<p>Each inmate shall be allowed one hour of supervised physical exercise or physical recreation at least three days per week.</p> <p>During a review of recreation logs, documentation did not indicate that inmates are being offered recreation three times in a seven day period.</p>
