The ability to determine if an inmate booked into your facility has been designated as having an Intellectual or Developmental Disability (IDD) has now been added to TLETS. Utilizing the same format and process as the CCQ check, this additional feature is part of the continuing effort to identify and connect inmates with mental health or IDD issues with resources that are available.

Contact information for the Local Intellectual or Developmental Disability Authority (LIDDA) is attached for your convenience. If you have not already established a line of communication with your LIDDA, please do so.

Please note that if a positive or probable return is received, the jail **SHALL** notify the LIDDA and magistrate in order to comply with the requirements of CCP 16.22. **Utilize the same process and procedures you currently use for an exact or possible/probable CCQ match when notifying the LIDDA and magistrate of an exact or possible/probable IDD match.** Failure to do so may result in a notice of non-compliance being issued.

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q1. When the project starts, will jail staff re-screen the people already in jail? Or will the new project/process include only persons who are newly processed into jail after the project begins?

A. Jail staff will not re-screen individuals already in jail, only those newly processed into county jails.

Q2. Will every person who is flagged as a match automatically meet the criteria for crisis intervention services due to their incarceration? Or will LIDDA staff screen each person to determine their needs as they are flagged and refer to intake/outside resources if it's not a "crisis"?

A. No, they will not automatically meet the criteria for services. The LIDDA

should follow procedures for screening each person to determine their needs and refer to intake/outside resources if it's not a "crisis."

Q3. Once someone is flagged, will the jails have an expectation that these individuals be released immediately and want crisis respite services while LIDDAs pursue alternative placement?

A. No, this is not the expectation of the jails.
