1	265	.3	<p>Observation During Holding. Inmates confined in a holding cell or detoxification cell shall be observed by facility personnel at intervals not to exceed 30 minutes.</p> <p>After reviewing observation logs of inmates in holding/detox, the jail staff are not conducting 30 minute face-to-face observations of inmates on a regular basis in accordance with minimum jail standards.</p>
2	285	.1	<p>Physical Exercise. Each facility shall have and implement a written plan, approved by the Commission, for inmate physical exercise and physical recreation. Documentation of physical exercise and physical recreation shall be maintained for Commission review. Each inmate shall be allowed one hour of supervised physical exercise or physical recreation at least three days per week.</p> <p>During the review of recreation documentation, it was determined inmates are not receiving 1 hour of recreation 3 days per week as required by minimum jail standards.</p>
3	285	.2	<p>Sunlight. Inmates confined longer than 10 days shall be allowed access to sunlight no less than 1 hour weekly.</p> <p>During the review of recreation documentation, it was determined that inmates are not receiving access to sunlight at least one hour weekly as required by minimum jail standards.</p>
