Enclosed is a copy of our Paper Ready Inmate Reports which is reflective of the number of inmates, as reported by the counties, for whom paperwork and processing has been completed for admittance into the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division. The enclosed report encompasses the months of September 2020 through November 2020.

In November, the number of “new paper-ready inmates” decreased by 521. The average number of new paper-ready inmates per month over the last twelve months is 2,159. This month’s number is 425 less than the average. In November, the total number of paper-ready inmates held in the county jails was 1,736 a decrease of 1,007 from the previous month. The number of transfers from the county jails to TDCJ-ID decreased by 1,740.
