1	273	.2(7)	Provide procedures for the distribution of prescriptions in accordance with written instructions from a physician by an appropriate person designated by the sheriff/operator; Review of Medication Administration Records (MARs) failed to show that medications are distributed in accordance with written instructions from a physician.
2	273	.6(3)	A documented observation of the inmate shall be conducted every 15 minutes, at a minimum. The observations should include an assessment of the security of the restraints and the circulation to the extremities. Restraint logs indicated staff exceeded the required 15 minute observation checks by 1 to 17 minutes on multiple occasions.
