The status of inmates placed in administrative separation shall be reviewed and documented at least every 30 days for continuance of status.</p> <p>Status reviews of inmates housed in administrative separation were not conducted at least every 30 days for continuance of status.</p>
2	271	.1 (b)(3)	<p>A custody reassessment shall be conducted within 30 - 90 days of the Initial Custody Assessment and immediately upon any disciplinary action and/or change in legal status which would affect classification. A documented classification review to determine the necessity for a complete reassessment shall be conducted every 30 - 90 days thereafter.</p> <p>Custody reassessments are not being conducted within 30-90 days of the initial custody assessment and immediately upon any disciplinary action. And a documented classification review to determine the necessity for a complete reassessment is not being conducted every 30-90 days thereafter.</p>
3	273	.2 (7)	<p>Provide procedures for the distribution of prescriptions in accordance with written instructions from a physician by an appropriate person designated by the sheriff/operator;</p> <p>Review of Medication Administration Records failed to show that medications are distributed in accordance with written instructions from a physician.</p>
4	285	.1	<p>Documentation of physical exercise and physical recreation shall be maintained for Commission review. Each inmate shall be allowed one hour of supervised physical exercise or physical recreation at least three days per week.</p> <p>During the review it was noted that documentation provided failed to show that inmates are allowed one hour of supervised recreation at least three days per week.</p>
