1	271	.3	Training. The plan shall provide that all staff whose duties include classification, shall undergo at least four hours of training on the principles, procedures and instruments for classification assessments, housing assignments, reassessments and inmate needs. Staff who have not completed the required four hours of classification training are performing classification duties.
2	273	.2 (7)	Provide procedures for the distribution of prescriptions in accordance with written instructions from a physician by an appropriate person designated by the sheriff/operator; Review of Medication Administration Records failed to show that medications are distributed in accordance with written instructions from a physician.
	285	.1	Documentation of physical exercise and physical recreation shall be maintained for Commission review. Each inmate shall be allowed one hour of supervised physical exercise or physical recreation at least three days per week. During the review, it was noted that documentation provided failed to show that inmates are allowed one hour of supervised recreation at least three days per week.
