Please reference the Inspection Requirements Review and Jail Inspection Report issued on August 24, 2023, detailing the specific issues that resulted in the issuance of this notice of non-compliance.

273. 5(a)(1)	Each sheriff/operator shall develop and implement a mental disabilities/suicide prevention plan, in coordination with available medical and mental health officials, approved by the Commission by March 31, 1997. The plan shall address the following principles and procedures:(1) Training. Provisions for staff training (including frequency and duration) on the procedures for recognition, supervision, documentation, and handling of inmates who are mentally disabled and/or potentially suicidal. Supplemental training should be provided to those staff members responsible for intake screening. (13) jailers did not receive 2 hours of suicide prevention training as required by the approved Mental Disabilities/Suicide Prevention Operational plan.	Upon receipt of this notice.
273.6 (3)	A documented observation of the inmate shall be conducted every 15 minutes, at a minimum. The observations should include an assessment of the security of the restraints and the circulation to the extremities. While reviewing inmate restraint observation logs, it was determined that jail exceeded the 15-minute observations from 1 minute up to 18 minutes on a consistent basis.	Upon receipt of this notice.
