Updated Offensive Severity Scale for use with Objective Jail Classification

With the assistance of the Correctional Management Institute of Texas at Sam Houston State University, the Texas Commission on Jail Standards has revised the offense severity scale. This will ensure that counties have the most appropriate instrument to classify inmates and house them in the least restrictive housing available without jeopardizing staff, inmates, or the public.
