## NOTICE OF NON-COMPLIANCE CROCKETT COUNTY JAIL

September 23, 2024

Please reference the Inspection Requirements Review and Jail Inspection Report issued on September 19, 2024, detailing the specific issues that resulted in the issuance of this notice of non-compliance.

Minimum Standards Violated:	Corrective Measure Required	Date Corrective Action Must Be Completed
263.56	Emergency power equipment shall be tested at least once each week and the electric load transferred to the circuits at least monthly. <b>A review of the generator logs revealed that a weekly load test was not conducted the week of August 4-10, 2024 and no load test was conducted for the months July and August 2024.</b>	Upon receipt of this notice.
273.5(b)	(b) Screening Instrument. An approved mental disabilities/suicide prevention screening instrument shall be completed immediately on all inmates admitted. <b>On 2 occasions the suicide questionnaire was not completed in it's entirety as there was no indication of the magistrate being notified. On another occasion, the magistrate notification form indicates no notification necessary, while the questionnaire contained a litany of affirmative responses requiring notification.</b>	Upon receipt of this notice.
273.5(c)(2)	(2) maintain documentation to be available at the time of inspection showing that information for each inmate designated in paragraph (1) of this subsection was submitted for CCQ/IDD system checks, to include notification to the magistrate and the Local Mental Health Authority or Local Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Authority as per CCP 16.22(a)(1) <b>On 1 occasion the magistrate was notified after 14 hours, exceeding the time frame required by CCP 16.22 by 2 hours. On 2 occasions the LMHA was not notified as required by affirmative responses on the questionnaire.</b>	Upon receipt of this notice.
