The facility shall be inspected annually by a local fire official who is certified by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection or who meets the alternative criteria provided in Government Code 419.909 and shall pass the inspection. 263.56	Emergency power equipment shall be tested at least once each week and the electric load transferred to the circuits at least monthly.
