The plan should include programs for voluntary participation by inmates such as: For the month of January 2025, 6 of 9 housing units and 5 inmates in single housing, were not offered physical exercise or physical recreation 1 hour, 3 times per week as required. A subsequent review of the month of March 2025 revealed that again 6 of 9 housing units and 6 inmates in single housing not were offered physical recreation or physical exercise 1 hour, 3 times per week.
