## TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE MEMORANDUM #25-5

RE: Changes to Minimum Jail Standards

The Texas Commission on Jail Standards voted to adopt amendments to Texas Administrative Code Chapter 263 Life Safety, at its August 7, 2025, meeting. These rules changes were suggested, and reviewed, at the TCJS Administrative Rules Advisory Committee, during its 4-year rule review, with the help of the State Fire Marshal's Office and other stakeholders. These rules can be found on TCJS' website <a href="here">here</a>. These rules changes are primarily non-substantive grammatical corrections and include clarifying changes to certain references, and will not affect your current operations.

TCJS also voted to adopt rule changes to Chapter 279.1, Sanitation Plan, that requires jails to develop a method to allow hand washing in holding cells and include the plan in their operational plan. This rule change was proposed by a petition from the public and was reviewed by the TCJS Administrative Rules Advisory Committee. See the text of the adopted rule <a href="here">here</a>.
