The Committee members present at the roll call were Lee Johnson, Dr. Fegan-Bohm, Nicole Hawk, Dr. Pinon, Bryan Camphire, Emily Eisenman, Ann McGonigle, and Sonja Burns. Sheriff Stallman was absent. Staff members present included Interim Executive Director Armstrong, Assistant Director Courtney Holm, Assistant Director Stephenie Reneau, Richard Morgan and Gabriel Farley.

III. **Reading and Approval of Minutes**

- a. A motion was made by Cullen Grissom to approve the previous meeting minutes and seconded by Bryan Camphire.

IV. **Public Comment – Held after New Business**

- a. Commissioner Alisa Simmons – Identified herself as the Tarrant County Commissioner from Precinct 2, and spoke in support of families in her district with children with IDD, and in support of jail related IDD improvements. Discussed goals for a plan from the state of Texas, Tarrant County, LMHA, county Hospital, advocacy partners, and HHSC, for crisis respite capacity.

- b. Dr. Katherine Godby – Retired pastor, cofounder of Justice Network of Tarrant County. Discussed individuals with IDD and incarceration. Provided specific examples of individuals with IDD in jail. Recommended expanding state supported living centers and crisis response and crisis stabilization units.
- c. Christy Bridgman – Discussed her son in Tarrant County Jail, who has IDD, and other disabilities. She described the difficulties that her son has experienced in the state supported living centers, including her son’s experience during crisis at a group home.
- d. Nan Terry – Discussed Sabrina Harris’ experience with IDD and Harris County Jail. She discussed that Sabrina Harris is her adult-daughter’s guardian. She discussed her and her daughter’s experience with guardianship and the jail. Her testimony included commentary on the SSLC condition including the lack of respite facilities.
- e. Krish Gundu – Provided testimony regarding the IDDAC’s report due at the end of the year. She discussed data that was not in the previous reports. She discussed wanting data transparency and wanted a report that included qualitative data. She discussed the anecdotal data provided during public comments at previous IDDAC meetings.

V. **Old Business**

- a. **Guardianship** – Judge Jahn, Denton County Judge, and his team, presented information on the guardianship process from the court’s perspective, and the guardianship rules that the IDDAC promulgated to the TCJS ARAC to publish for public comment. No action taken.
- b. **Subcommittee Updates** - The subcommittee chairs provided updates on their work. No significant updates, no action taken.
- c. **CIT Program Texas Governors Committee for People with Disabilities** – Mr. Geron McGlory was in attendance to provide crisis program testimony as requested by the Committee. No representative from the TGCPD were in attendance to provide presentation.
