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NOTICE OF NON-COMPLIANCE SCHLEICHER COUNTY JAIL

Please reference the Inspection Requirements Review and Jail Inspection Report issued on August 10, 2026, detailing the specific issues that resulted in the issuance of this notice of non-compliance.

271.1(a)(1)(B)	(1) inmates shall be classified and housed in the least restrictive housing available without jeopardizing staff, inmates or the public, utilizing risk factors which include any or all of the following: (B) offense history; On 2 occasions staff failed to notate an assaultive felony in the criminal history.	Upon receipt of this notice.
275.1(b)(3)	(3) Custody Reassessment/Review. A custody reassessment shall be conducted within 30 - 90 days of the Initial Custody Assessment and immediately upon any disciplinary action and/or change in legal status which would affect classification. A documented classification review to determine the necessity for a complete reassessment shall be conducted every 30 - 90 days thereafter. Staff failed to reclassify upon receipt of a detainer from another jurisdiction.	Upon receipt of this notice.
